Our Promise To You:

- We will provide high quality equipment, arts and crafts supplies and sensory resources every day to extend your child's nursery experience
- We will upload observations to their online learning story and provide daily diary updates via the EYParent app – we recommend you download it!
- We will provide water wipes that are safe for your child's skin, and will provide suncream that is dermatologically tested, paediatrician approved and factor 50. If you wish to provide a specific cream to support sensitivities/allergies this is of course welcomed.
- We will provide your child with a nutritious and filling snack in the morning and afternoon, with the option of milk (cows, oat or soya) or water. We will ensure they stay well hydrated in the day.
- We will provide a healthy and tasty 2 course lunch following the nursery menu, providing alternatives for identified allergies or intolerances.
- We won't charge any further extra's for outings, special visitors or experiences at nursery.

Funding:

- We accept 15 hours and 30 hours funding, or the option for you to stretch your funding 12 hours or 24 hours all year round, across 48 weeks. See page 2 for further info. Flying Start offer a free funded place to all children in receipt of 2 year disadvantaged funding or a designated children in need.
- We encourage you to explore the government's Tax-Free Childcare scheme which saves you an extra 20% on any non-funded fees.
- All customers who opt-in to paying Meals, Snacks and Consumables when using funded hours will benefit from free Meals, Snacks and Consumables when paying private fees.

We ask you:

- To ensure you adhere to our drop off and collection times. To help us offer high quality uninterrupted teaching times please drop off by 9.30am in the morning and by 1pm for an afternoon session, and collect at 12, 1 or 3pm at the earliest and then from 3pm in agreement with your nursery booking pattern.
- To let us know if you are going to be late, and expect a late charge of £10 for more than 10 minutes, and subsequent charges for longer durations – as we pay our staff to stay on!
- To take responsibility for checking your funding code and ensuring it remains valid via your government gateway account (usually 3 month checks required), understanding if your code is not valid you will have nursery fees to pay.
